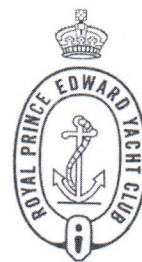


**ROYAL PRINCE EDWARD YACHT CLUB**  
**Wednesday Series 2025/2026**  
**Weather Conditions**



The RPEYC race committee wishes to clarify the weather conditions under which the Club will start the Wednesday series 2025/2026 race when wind warnings are published on the Bureau of meteorology website.

In the following circumstances racing will be abandoned -

- Gale warnings and above for Sydney coastal and closed waters.
- Strong wind warnings of 30 knots and above for Sydney closed waters during the race.
- Severe thunderstorm warnings forecast for Sydney area during the race.

Should it become apparent that the wind strength above 30 knots may be experienced during the race, the race committee will:

- Advise competitors by SMS at 1030 that the race is likely to be abandoned.
- Confirm that decision by SMS at 1230.
- Fly the appropriate signals from the RPEYC flag mast.

The club endeavours to promote safe and enjoyable racing however weather forecasts are just that and at times maybe less than accurate.

Competitors, please note sailing instructions and R RS4:

- Cause 16.8.1 - all those taking part in this race do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- RRS4 - the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.
